What is the purpose of the Leadership Symposium?

The Leadership Symposium will address the impact and major requirements of No Child Left Behind as well as other topics of importance to neglected, delinquent and correctional facilities.

Who should attend?

The Leadership Symposium is intended for administrators and instructional staff serving children in Pennsylvania's facilities for neglected, delinquent and correctional youth and the LEAs that serve these programs.

Who will speak at the Symposium?
